- I acknowledge that I am responsible for my pieces and cleaning glaze off the bottom to prevent them sticking to kiln shelves. I am also aware that damage to EAS&G kiln shelves results in a fee depending on severity up to \$200.*
- All the information I have provided to The Eccentric Artist Studio & Gallery is truthful.*

Statement of Liability:

Although the utmost care will be taken when firing the work provided, there is always a chance the piece will crack or potentially explode. This could be due to issues such as errors in craftsmanship, excessive thickness, inclusions accidentally mixed into the clay, or potential kiln malfunction. The Eccentric Artist Studio & Gallery assumes no responsibility for any of the above-mentioned firing or building issues that may occur, and you are still responsible for payment in full for firing services. The Eccentric Artist Studio & Gallery has the right to refuse any work - All accepted pieces are up to our kiln master's or staff's discretion.

By submitting your work to the Eccentric Artist Studio & Gallery for renting kiln space, you authorize The Eccentric Artist Studio & Gallery to take and use images of your pieces for promotional materials with credit to the original artist. Piece drop-off is **by appointment only** during Open Studio hours. Pickup for bisqueware or finished pieces on the day of unloading will be **between 4-5pm. We do not fire "rush" pieces.** All work is fired on a first come first serve basis, with in-house student work always taking priority.
